## PACKING LIST

#### Clothes

- \* Shorts, jeans, shirts, t-shirts, and other casual items may be worn during the week. Blue jeans or blue jeans shorts and camp T-shirt will be dress for the concert.
- \* Sleeping clothes
- \* Some will want some extra athletic type clothing depending on what they choose to do during afternoon rec time (basketball, ultimate frisbee, etc).

  <u>Unfortunately due to college Covid protocols we will not have access to the swimming pool this summer.</u>
- \* Lightweight jackets or hoodie in case of cool weather or cold temps inside buildings (we can dream<sup>©</sup>).
- \* Socks and shoes with as much walking as we will do, we do not recommend wearing flip flops all week!
- Laundry bag or trash bags for dirty clothes
- \* Umbrella, poncho or raincoat (<u>you will need this at some point</u>)!
- \* Mask or face covering Gordon State is still asking that masks be worn inside certain common areas (while walking through inside buildings in a group, while going through cafeteria lines, etc.)

#### Linens

- \* Twin size bedding or a sleeping bag to put on the mattress, pillow and pillow case, and a blanket. **Dorms** can get cold at night.
- \* Towels and washcloths (make sure you have enough for the whole week as there is not laundry service available)
- \* Plastic shower curtain or liner with rings this is new for this year. There will be a bar but each room will need a curtain or liner and rings to hang it with

- \* Toilet Paper this is new for this year. Toilet paper will not be provided by the college.

## Cleaning Items/Supplies

- \* Trash bags for the dorm room these will not be provided by the college this year
- \* Paper towels/cleaning wipes/broom to have in case of any minor spills or messes throughout the week. They should let their dorm counselor know in the event of a major issue. Rooms will have to be cleaned up before departure and it is much easier to keep it clean through the week than trying to do it all at once!

#### Miscellaneous

- \* Phones and Personal electronics (students are 100% responsible for keeping up with these)
- \* Students should not be using phones during band rehearsals and master classes. Please plan to talk and text with your student during afternoon rec time or in the evening after rehearsals have finished. If you have an emergency during rehearsal times and can't reach them you can call/text us at 678-643-7766.
- \* Alarm clock or phone/Ipod etc with alarm clock students will need to get up on time and be ready to leave for breakfast at the appropriate time. Their dorm counselor will also help to make sure they get up in the morning especially if they have a hard time!
- \* Money for snacks/drinks/souvenirs from camp store

## Musical Equipment

- \* Instrument Woodwind and Brass players must provide their own instruments and necessary accessories (reeds, valve oil, slide grease etc). Percussionists should bring a snare drum (if you have one) along with sticks and any bell/xylophone/timpani mallets you may already have.
- \* All students should bring a <u>folding music stand</u> for use in rehearsal or master class as needed
- \* All students should have a **pencil** for rehearsal
